



REMOVE OLD TOILET

- 1. Shut off water supply line. If you do not have shut-off valve near the toilet shut off main water supply line.
- 2. Flush the old toilet and make sure that tank is empty.
- 3. Disconnect and remove water supply line connected to the toilet's tank.
- 4. Remove old toilet, bolts, nuts from the closet flange.
- 5. Clean closet flange area from old wax ring and putty sealant using putty knife from the base area.
- 6. Clean any remaining debris and wipe any water at the installation area
- 7. Temporarily plug flange on a floor with a flange plug or towel to prevent gasses from escaping

IMPORTANT! The mounting surface area must be clean, dry, and leveled prior to installation of the new toilet!


NOTE! Inspect the existing closet flange for damages. If damaged, replace it to new flange before proceeding to the installation

PREPARE CLOSET FLANGE

Make sure that rough-in is 12" by measuring the distance from the wall to the center of the closet flange.

See Figure 1

Step 1. Insert 2 floor bolts inside of the toilet flange Step 2. Slide the closet bolts through the holes and align bolts horizontaly. See Figure 2



INSTALL WAX RING


Important: safety glasses must be worn by the installer and all bystanders.

Cover the floor with a soft-close blanket. Carefully turn the toilet on it's side or upside-down on the blanket with assistance of a second person. Install wax ring over the horn discharge located on the bottom of the toilet's bowl. *See Figure 3*

Note: Ceramic is a fragile material. You must always cover the floor with a soft-cloth blanket if you want to put the toilet on the floor on any side other than the bottom of the toilet. If you do not cover the floor with a soft-close blanket contact of the toilet with the floor may and will cause minor or moderate scratches on the toilet's surface.

INSTALL NEW TOILET

Step 1. Lift and carefully put the toilet over the closet flange so the closet bolts can go through the mounting holes in the toilet's base. Once the bowl is in the position press the bowl down with slight twisting motion in level position towards the floor. Apply your body weight to evenly compress the wax ring to create watertight seal. Make sure that the bowl is as leveled as possible to have a nice seal tight.

Do not rock the toilet back and forth and side to side as it may and will break a seal and you will need to replace the wax ring again and start the installation process over. *See Figure 4*

Step 2. Once the toilet is set and leveled install washers and nuts over the closet bolts. Tighten nuts. Do not overtighten the nuts. It may and will cause damage to the toilet's ceramic base.

CONNECT TOILET'S TANK TO WATER SUPPLY LINE

Connect the water supply line between the tank and water shut-off valve using a toilet hose (not supplied). When connecting toilet hose tighten coupling nut to the tank by 1/4 turn beyond the hand tight.

> Do not overtighten nut on the tank connection. It may and will cause water leakage.

Turn on valve on water supply line and allow tank to fill. Check all connections for leakages and tighten as needed.

Once tank is filled with water flush it 4-5 times to perform a test of the flushing system. At the same time check the bottom of the toilet for leaks to make sure that the wax ring is properly installed and sealed.

If there are no leaks you are ready finalize the installion. If any shims are installed at the bottom of the toilet's bowl you may trim them. Apply silicone around base of the toilet's. Allow 24 hours for silicone to dry before start using the toilet. *See Figure 6*

Important: Leaks may not occur during or right after the installation. Make sure to check for leaks every couple hours first day installed and and occasionally check it everyday for the next week to ensure that toilet is properly installed and no leaks occur. If any leaks occur immediately shut off the water supply line valve and contact your local plumber to fix all leaks.



2. Installation and disassembly of main unit

Installation of Main Unit: Push the main unit into the base plate until it locks with a "click" sound.

Disassembly of Main Unit: Press the "Release button", and pull out the main unit when a "click" sound is heard.

* Once the Release Button is pressed, you do not have to hold it during disassembly process.



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
PREPARATION

Preparation

1. Turn on the angle valve

Check the threaded connection for leaks to ensure complete sealing. Turn the angle valve counterclockwise to the full open position.

(Note: The angle valve opens with a large torque for the first time.)




2. Power Connection

Insert the leakage protection plug into a power socket, press the reset switch, plug indicator lights up, indicating that the power is on.

Note:

Press the test button prior to usage, the reset switch pops up and the indicator light goes off, indicating that the leakage protection function is normal.

Press the TEST button (then RESET button) every month to assure proper operation.

3. Self-inspection

1. Once power is connected, the buzzer beeps once. The white light on knob (button) flashes, and the self-inspection starts.

2. The buzzer beeps again, then the self-inspection completes, and the knob (button) lights up in white.

3. The product is ready to use.

Auto lid open/close

If you purchase the intelligent toilet with auto lid open/close function, the product can achieve the function of auto lid open/close.



Button User Guide

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- 1. When not seated, short press the button and the spray wand will automatically extend for cleaning.
- 2. When the human body is seated, short press the button to start the one button rear wash function: rear wash \rightarrow drying \rightarrow automatic stop drying.
- 3. When the human body is seated, press and hold the button to start the one button front wash function: front wash \rightarrow drying \rightarrow automatic stop drying.
- 4. When the rear wash, front wash and drying functions are turned on, short press the button to immediately stop the current function.
- 5. When not seated, press and hold the button to enter standby mode. Short press the button in standby mode to enter function mode; Function mode-When the product is working, the button indicator light is on; When no one is using it, the button indicator light will turn off after a period of time. If any function is used again, the button indicator light will return to display. Standby mode-button indicator light will turn off

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Maintenance

Maintenance of Main Unit

- 1. Shut off power supply before doing maintenance.
- 2. Use only a soft, damp cloth to clean. Avoid using harsh chemicals.

3. Once cleaning is completed and all surfaces are dry, re-connect the power plug.







Note: Do not rinse the surface of the product directly with water during maintenance.

Nozzle Maintenance


When there is dirt on the nozzle, maintain it according to the following methods:

1. When no one is seated, turn the knob clockwise (press Rear Washing Button). The nozzle will automatically stretch out to allow access for cleaning.

2. Nozzle can be removed and cleaned separately. (Hold the spray wand with one hand and pull the nozzle out with the other hand)

3. Put the nozzle back on and press the "Stop" button on the main unit or remote control to return the spray wand to its normal position.





Note: Do not pull or push the wand, to avoid damage.

Deodorizing Device Maintenance


Remove the screws from the underside of unit as shown below to access the deodorizing cartridge.



Product filter maintenance

- 1. Plug off the power cord, switch off the angle valve, remove the cover, and place the cover upside down.
- 2. Use a screwdriver (flat headed) to insert the position of the plug hole shown in the figure, and then lift out the plug to remove it.



3. Remove the water inlet pipe from the product.

Filter

- 4. Use needle-nose pliers to remove the filter screen from the water inlet. Clean dirt with a toothbrush or small brush.
- 5. After cleaning, install the filter back into the water inlet, connect the water inlet pipe, and replace the plug.
- 6. Reinstall the cover for function properly.

(take out with needle-nose pliers)

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Reminder: During cleaning, do not lose or damage the filter components and the sealing ring on the filter screen connector, otherwise it may cause water leakage.
